**For learners who will attend BARON ELEMENTARY appointments are available on:**

March 20, 2023 from 8:00 AM – 2:00 PM and 4:30 PM – 6:45 PM (appointment is required)

**For learners who will attend DOE RUN ELEMENTARY appointments are available on:**

March 16, 2023 from 8:00 AM – 2:00 PM and 4:30 PM – 6:45 PM (appointment is required)

March 21, 2023 from 8:00 AM – 2:00 PM (appointment is required)

*There will be no screening/student assessment at this time. We ask that only the Primary Parent/Guardian come to the appointment. Please **DO NOT** bring your child. The appointments will be for registration only along with an informational meeting with the Principals, Transportation, and Nursing Staff.*

**When you come in for your appointment, you MUST have a valid photo ID and you MUST bring the following documents:**

- 1) **PROOF OF YOUR CHILD'S AGE** (examples: Birth Certificate; Passport)
- 2) **YOUR CHILD'S IMMUNIZATION RECORD – showing all vaccines to date.**
- 3) **PROOF OF RESIDENCY** (*lease/rental agreement or mortgage document, utility bill*)



Documents required if applicable to you:

Affidavit for Proof of Guardianship  
Notarized Parent Custodial Agreement  
Agency Letter if Foster  
IEP (*document for students needing special services*)

***Important Change in the Definition of “Compulsory School Age”***

*Effective in the 2020-2021 School Year, all children from the age of six (6) through the age of eighteen (18) must comply with compulsory school attendance requirements. To meet these requirements, parents must ensure that their child between the ages of 6 and 18 is attending or participating in one of the following: a public elementary, middle, or high school; a public charter or cyber-charter school; a private licensed academic or private religious school; home tutoring by a certified teacher; or an approved program of home schooling.
