	822. AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR (AED)
1. Purpose	The attached describes the policies and procedures of the Manheim Central School District relating to its early defibrillation program, utilizing employees who serve as trained responders in CPR and AED therapy in the event of a medical emergency.
2. Delegation of Responsibility	It is the responsibility of the program administrators to provide continuous guidance, monitoring, and evaluation to the program contents. All AED Response Team Members must operate within the parameters of this early defibrillation program.
3. Guidelines	The Manheim Central School District schools provide a medical emergency response that includes basic first aid, cardiopulmonary resuscitations (CPR), and emergency defibrillation. The goal of the early defibrillation program is to participate actively in the chain of survival by providing early defibrillation to any victim.
