

## Your Uninsured Child May Be Eligible

Based on your family's size and income, your child or teen may be eligible if he or she is:

- Under 19 years of age.
- A U.S. citizen, U.S. national, or qualified alien.
- A resident of Pennsylvania.
- Uninsured and not eligible for or enrolled in Medical Assistance.

To keep your children covered, you have to renew every year—it's not automatic, but it's easy. Capital BlueCross will send you a renewal form 90 days before your coverage ends, and we can help you through the process.

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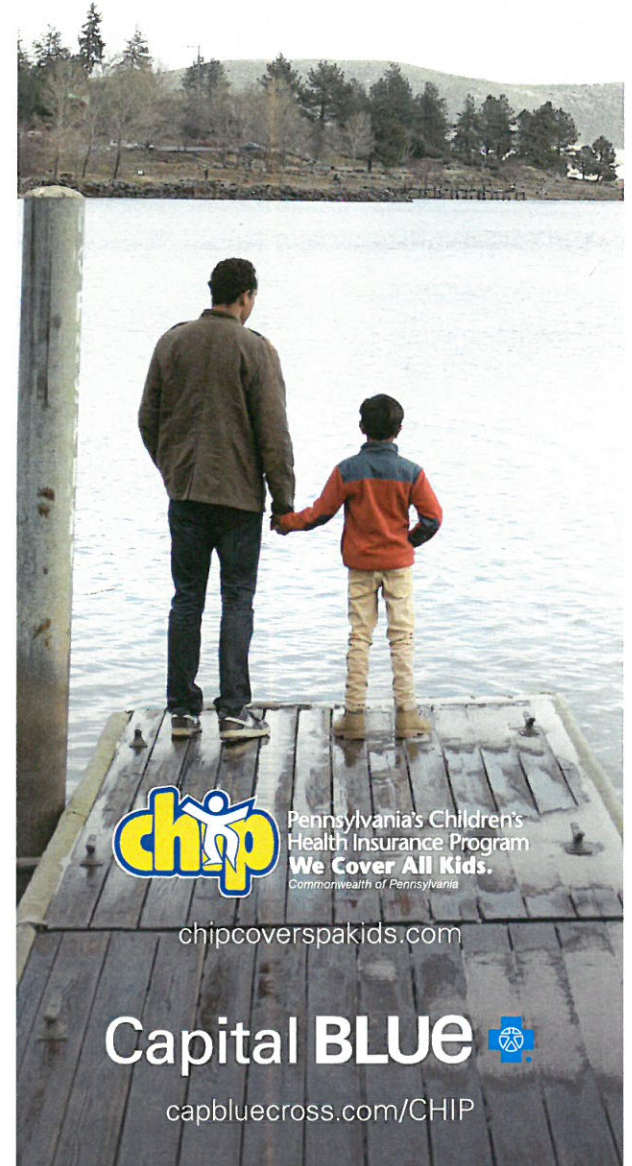

## What is CHIP?

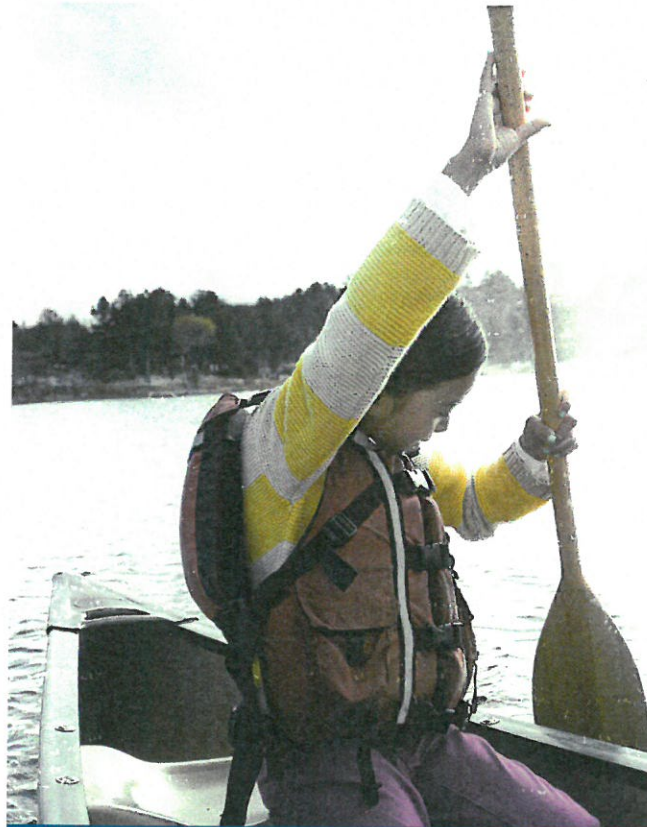
CHIP is short for Pennsylvania's Children's Health Insurance Program—Pennsylvania's program to provide health insurance to uninsured children and teens. CHIP now provides free and affordable health insurance to all uninsured children and teens (up to age 19) who are not eligible for Medical Assistance. No family makes too much money for CHIP. Take a look at the information inside and see how your family can benefit from CHIP.

Here's what to have on hand:

- Your total household income before taxes (including wages, child support, unemployment, etc.)
- Social Security number of household members who are applying for CHIP
- Birth dates of household members
- Current or recent health insurance information, if applicable
- Proof of citizenship or legal residency of applicant (if not a U.S. citizen)

## How to Apply

### Apply online:

### Apply by mail:

Print a copy of the application at [capbluecross.com/CHIP](http://capbluecross.com/CHIP). Simply fill it out and mail it along with any necessary paperwork to the address provided on the application.

Or call **1.800.KIDS.101 (1.800.543.7101)** to request a paper application, **TTY: 711**. They will be happy to send you one and help answer your questions.

*If your income is below CHIP guidelines, your child may be enrolled in Medical Assistance.*
